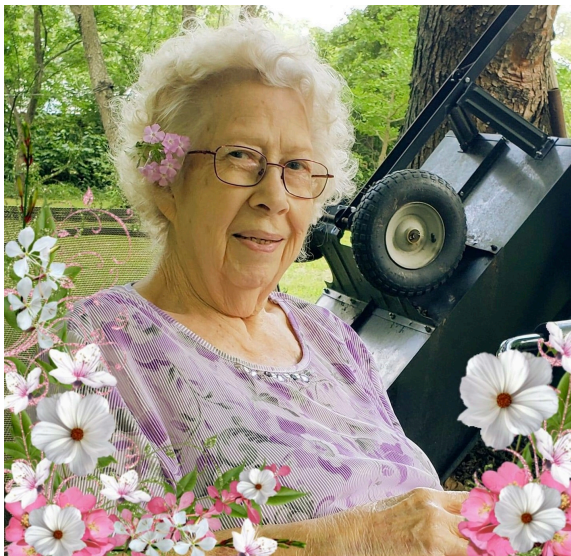


85 year old, Josephine Conley, of DeMotte, passed away August 3, 2018.
