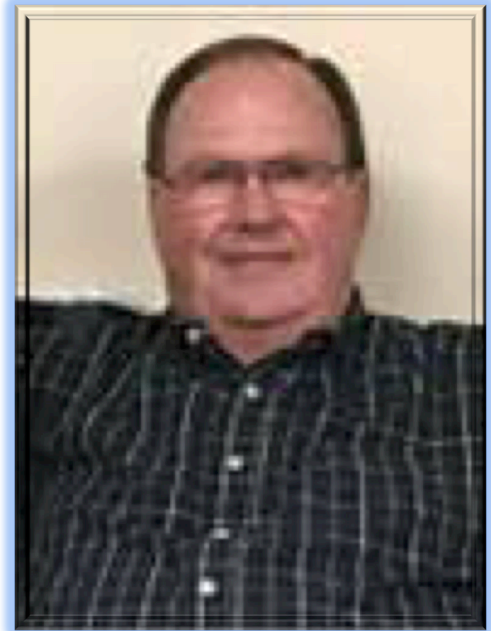


75 year old, Connie L. Flick, of Monticello, formerly of DeMotte, passed away September 9, 2018.
